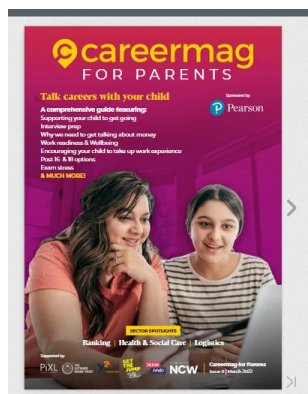


## Careers Newsletter - May 2022

The workforce is projected to grow by 4.3% over the period to 2027, creating 600 jobs. In the same period, 55.3% of the workforce is projected to retire, creating 8,100 job openings.
